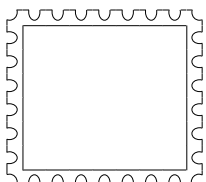

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows/Registration and Discipline" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I agree to hold the AKC and any AKC approved judge harmless from any legal claim resulting from said AKC judge's action under the AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. Please be advised of the following about Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility:

ALL dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC.

The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.

To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Involving Single Dog Entries, to be judged after Winners but before Best of Breed.)

Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch: Open to any dog seven (7) years of age or older, on or prior to the day of the show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Involving Multiple Dog Entries, to be judged after Best of Breed.)

Stud Dog: For Stud Dogs and at least two, but not more than four of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. The Stud Dog will be the regular entry, this being the regular entry fee, plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with his Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its Breed. Each Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class of the same show. The entry form of each Get must state this competition and requires no additional fee.

Brood Bitch: Same as above except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog", "Produce" for "Get" and "her" for "his".

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these Classes.

IMPORTANT • NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS READ CAREFULLY

(This notice applies to **ALL** three shows.)

- ENTRY FEES: See Page Four.
- A RECORDING FEE of \$0.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee will be collected by the Clubs and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (Chapter 11, Sec. 2, AKC Rules).
- CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is 12:00 NOON, WEDNESDAY • FEBRUARY 10, 2010, at the Show Administrator's office, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Sec. 6 of the AKC Rules. TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, FACSIMILE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES FROM EXHIBITORS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE SHOW ADMINISTRATOR.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- MAIL ENTRIES WITH FEES TO: **MRS. TONI STEVENS, SHOW ADMINISTRATOR • 3839 SIOUX AVENUE • KINGMAN, AZ 86401.** Overnight entries to same address. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to B.C.M.A. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST MAKE FEES PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS. SHOW ADMINISTRATOR assumes NO responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, or whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made, however, no refund will be made if entry has been processed.
- REFUNDS OF \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations.
- RETURNED CHECKS & POST-DATED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show ADMINISTRATOR will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a cash basis.
- ACKNOWLEDGMENT of entries will be made as soon as is practical. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show administrator.
- NOTE: "Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the onsite Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the start of the regular conformation judging at the show (Chapter 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules).
- THE SHOW SITE WILL BE AVAILABLE TO EXHIBITORS at 4:00 PM, Friday • February 26, 2010, until 12:00 AM; at 7:00 AM, Saturday, February 27, 2010, and on Sunday, February 28, 2010, until 5:00 PM. DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OVERNIGHT IN SHOW ROOM & GROOMING AREA. Dogs must be removed from the show site (ballroom) immediately following Best of Breed for each show. Vendors must vacate the building by 2:00 p.m., Sunday, February 28, 2010.
- SHOW HOURS: As shown on the Judging Program. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it at ring-side when its classes are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- THE BALLROOM DOORS WILL CLOSE after Best of Breed on Saturday and will reopen for the party. See inside last page of this premium for more information.
- ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON A LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.
- EXHIBITOR'S SHOULD FOLLOW their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination of any animal at or on the show grounds is required.
- IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 11, SEC. 11, AKC RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS: "Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. There shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding, nor any displaying of unentered dogs." The show-giving clubs will strictly enforce the above-stated rule. Violators will be subject to action by the Event Committee and if found in violation, suspension of AKC privileges may be recommended.
- THERE WILL BE NO SPACE provided for unentered dogs at this show.

- THE USE OF PRIVATE exercise pens will be governed by the Event Committee on the day of the show. Public exercise pens will be provided.
- GROOMING dogs in areas other than as designated is not permitted. This will be strictly enforced.
- CLASS CASH PRIZES will be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the Show Secretary is advised at once. The Secretary, Administrator, and Show-giving clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
- ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED the day of the show. None will be mailed. Any unclaimed trophies will revert to the general trophy fund after the showing of the breed. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days.
- NO DOGS OR FEED BOWLS ALLOWED IN RESTROOMS. Persons found violating this rule are subject to action by the Event Committee.
- Handicapped facilities are available.
- Please obey all posted signs. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HELP to maintain this site by assisting in keeping it in excellent condition.
- ALL EXHIBITORS ARE CHARGED with the responsibility of cleaning in and around their rooms, vehicles, crates and dogs. Please clean after your dog(s) immediately. Please dispose of all garbage in proper containers.
- NO ELECTRICAL HOOK-UPS are available for motor-homes. See page 5 for information.
- THE SHOW-GIVING CLUBS and the HOLIDAY INN SELECT and their members, agents or their employees assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any LOSS, DAMAGE or INJURY sustained by EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS, SPECTATORS or to any of their DOGS or PROPERTY, and further, they assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for INJURY to CHILDREN NOT UNDER CONTROL of PARENTS or GUARDIANS.
- NO CRATING OR GROOMING will be allowed near conformation ring.
- NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES ALLOWED in grooming area. Crates must be stackable.
- FIRE LANES in the parking area must be maintained at all times. Violators will be towed at owner's expense. The City of Atlanta prohibits parking in a handicap zone without proper permit being displayed. Violators are subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- NO CRATES ALLOWED AT RINGSIDE OVERNIGHT!! NO GROOMING TABLES OR CHAIRS LEFT OVERNIGHT. THEY WILL BE REMOVED!!!
- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE EATING AREAS OR RESTROOMS.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for their children at all times, both for their welfare and any damages they might incur. DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR ON THE SHOW SITE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AT ANY TIME.
- EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify the show administrator of any change of address.

•PLEASE BE ADVISED: The show-giving clubs and the Holiday Inn Select request your cooperation in keeping the premises and your rooms clean. Clean up after your dogs immediately. (In cooperation with the Housekeeping Staff, rooms will be checked at the Hotel.) No loose dogs in unattended areas or rooms, no bathing of dogs in any of the bathrooms and plastic sheeting must be placed under every crate. If anyone is found to be abusing the privileges of using these facilities, they will be asked to leave immediately, clean up and/or pay for any necessary cleanup, damages or repairs. Violation of these rules may also subject you to possible action by the Event Committee and AKC.
